Alastair was born in London on 29/7/1978. He is a director, writer and producer across documentary and drama.

INSIDE OUT is his second feature length documentary after his critically acclaimed debut TURN IT LOOSE which premiered at the Edinburgh International Film Festival 2009. It was picked up for theatrical release by MK2 Diffusion.

TURN IT LOOSE explores the hopes and aspirations of six young b-boys from all over the world in the run up to the break dancing BC One Championships held in a disused power station in Soweto, South Africa. Sight and Sound called the film “a jaw-droppingly visual feast of human movement and a nail-bitingly competitive battle of urban gladiatorial style. Not to be missed”.

Alastair went on to direct his first narrative feature In the Dark Half with BBC Films and Cinema Six. Described by Eye for Film as “a chilling and poignant masterpiece”, this award winning, micro-budget story about grief starring Jessica Barden and Tony Curran was picked up for theatrical release in the UK by Verve Pictures.

Alastair has also written a narrative film called Trespass Against Us for Film Four, which is currently being produced through Potboiler Productions. Film Four have commissioned him to write another.
