Emile Abinal has a degree from l'Ecole du Louvre and of the Sorbonne, in History of Art and Archeology.

His first experience in the field of digital arts, gave him the opportunity to learn production and exposition of contents (publications, conferences...) for institutions like the Pompidou Center and other foreign museums.

Appreciative of the hip-hop culture, particularly in graffiti, he befriends the French artist JR right at his beginnings in 2001. He collaborates occasionally with him in early 2003, launching his first two publications (Carnet de Rue and Portrait of a Generation). The collaboration becomes official when he committed in 2007 to JR's Face 2 Face project in Isreal and Palestine. Since then, he has orchestrated all production of JR's projects and coordinates his activities from Paris.

He is the co-founder since 2008 of the production company Social Animals, who co-produced JR's first film Women Are Heroes (2011) selected at the Festival de Cannes 2010 by the Semaine de la Critique. He is also the producer of the documentary Inside Out (2013) presented at the Tribeca Film Festival for their world premiere. He continues to develop documentary film projects related to JR or themes surrounding his work (Art and Activism, commitment, freedom, identity and image).
